

**DESIGNATION AND DELEGATION BY THE MINISTER OF PUBLIC SAFETY  
AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS UNDER THE IMMIGRATION AND  
REFUGEE PROTECTION ACT AND THE IMMIGRATION AND REFUGEE  
PROTECTION REGULATIONS**

Pursuant to subsection 6(1) of the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act*,

1. I hereby designate as an officer the person holding the position of President, Executive Vice-president or Vice-president of the Canada Border Services Agency - or a person authorized to exercise the powers or perform the duties and functions of one of those positions - to exercise the powers or perform the duties and functions of an officer that are described in column 3 of an item in the Schedule in relation to any provision of the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act* and the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Regulations* set out in column 2 of the same item.

2. I hereby designate any person holding a position listed in column 4 of an item in the Schedule - or a person authorized to exercise the powers or perform the duties and functions of that position- to exercise the powers or perform the duties and functions of an officer that are described in column 3 of the same item in relation to any provision of the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act* and the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Regulations* set out in column 2 of the item.

3. I hereby designate the person who has the direct supervisory responsibility of an officer designated under paragraph 2, in respect of the position held by that officer, as an officer to exercise the powers or perform the duties and functions of an officer that are described in column 3 of the item in the Schedule, for which the original officer had been designated, in relation to any provision of the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act* and the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Regulations* set out in column 2 of the same item.

Pursuant to subsection 6(2) of the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act*,


4. I hereby authorize the person holding the position of President, Executive Vice-president or Vice-president of the Canada Border Services Agency- or a person authorized to exercise the powers or perform the duties and functions of one of those positions - to do anything that may be done by the Minister of Public Safety and Emergency Preparedness which is described in column 3 of an item in the Schedule to this Instrument in relation to any provision of the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act* and the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Regulations* set out in column 2 of the same item.

5. I hereby authorize any person holding a position listed in column 4 of an item in the Schedule - or a person authorized to exercise the powers or perform the duties and functions of that position - to do anything that may be done by the Minister of Public Safety and Emergency Preparedness which is described in column 3 of the same item in relation to any provision of the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act* and the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Regulations* set out in column 2 of the item.

6. I hereby authorize the person who has the direct supervisory responsibility of a person authorized under paragraph 5, in respect of the position held by that person, to do anything that may be done by the Minister of Public Safety and Emergency Preparedness which is described in column 3 of the item in the Schedule, for which that original person had been authorized, in relation to any provision of the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act* and the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Regulations* set out in column 2 of the same item.

This document replaces the previous delegation and designation instrument signed by Mr. Alain Jolicoeur on April 13, 2007, and comes into force on the date of the signature.
